



## MASTERCRAFT A/S IV WHITE WALL TYRES WITH SIZES P235/75R15 AND P205/75R15 MANUFACTURED BETWEEN 8 TO 18 FEBRUARY 2017

**Identification**: The affected Mastercraft A/S IV white wall tyres were manufactured between 8 February 2017 and 18 February 2017, and supplied in Australia between 1 March 2017 and 31 December 2017. Each tyre is marked with a DOT Identification Number.

To determine if your tyre is subject to this recall, please:

- 1. Find the tyre's DOT Identification Number which is located on the lower sidewall of the tyre.
- 2. The DOT sequence begins with the code **R7HLFEB** or **R7ULFEB**. The last 4 digits of the DOT Identification Number is a date code which comprises of a 2-digit code for the week and a 2-digit code for the year of manufacture of the tyre. If your tyre's date code is either **0617 or 0717** your tyre is subject to this recall.

The following example depicts a DOT serial number ending with 0617.



**Defect**: Affected tyres were manufactured with an incorrect rubber compound on the belt wire which may result in poor adhesion of the rubber to the belt wires.

**Hazard**: The affected tyres may develop an in-service audible noise, unsatisfactory ride condition, belt separation, or distortion in the tread area that if undetected may ultimately result in a tyre failure leading to the loss of vehicle control and increase the risk of a possible crash.

**What to do**: If you believe you have an affected tyre, please immediately contact Exclusive Tyres to arrange for identification and replacement of any affected tyres free of charge.
